## Notes for Duncan Sterling MacKinnon

### Marriage Notes:

October 17, 1919:

McKinnon - O'Neal:

In St. Peter's church, North End, St. John, on Wednesday morning, 15th, an interesting wedding ceremony was performed by Rev. Edward Scully, CSSR, when he united in marriage Miss Helen Gertrude O'Neal, daughter of Thomas O'Neal, of North End, and Duncan MacKinnon, formerly of Sussex but lately of Saint John. The bride wore a pretty navy blue traveling suit with a hat of Copenhagen blue, and mink furs. She was attended by Miss Gertrude McNamara, dressed in a suit of Burgundy, with black picture hat, while the groom was supported by Dr. F.P. Flemming. Following the ceremony, breakfast was served at the Clifton House, after which Mr. & Mrs. MacKinnon left by steamer for Boston, where they will reside and where the best wishes of numerous friends for future happiness will follow them. Many wedding remembrances of a costly and valuable nature were received. The groom's present to the bride was a set of mink furs, to the bridesmaid, a ring, and to the groomsman, a tie pin.<sup>13</sup>
